Weaving 101+ is for beginning weavers, those who still need some guidance and weavers wanting to expand their knowledge of weaving. Instruction is for 4-shaft and rigid heddle*looms. The class requires that you do some weaving at home to complete one or more projects.

Yarns and Weave Structure with samples
Parts of a Loom and Weaving Tools
Reading a project draft (as presented in magazines)
Planning a Project
Selecting Yarn

Measuring warp
Warping your loom
Winding a shuttle
Weaving and finishing your project

Six 3-hour classes are offered Wednesday evenings and Thursday in the morning and afternoon. Classes are conducted in Redlands, and require a membership in the Inland Empire Handweavers Guild. Students may bring their own loom or rent (fee) a table loom from the guild.

Classes are limited to 3-4 students (three are required for a class to be offered). **Cost: \$200**. Includes materials for one project and a Guild membership (value \$30)
