

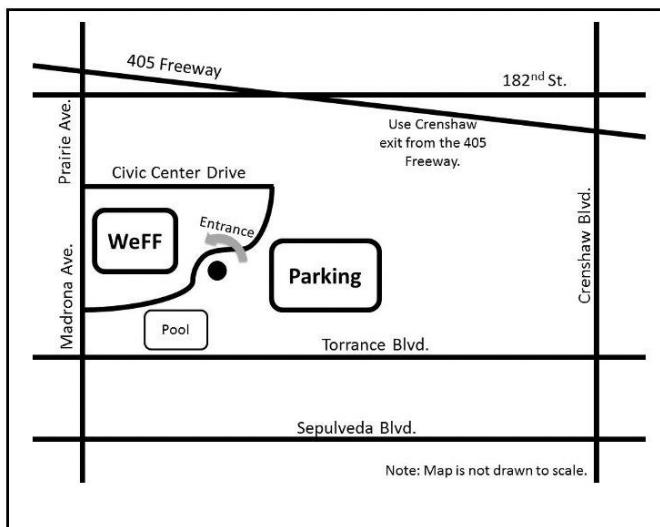


WeFF is Sunday, May 7, 2023 Fiber Fun for Creative People
