## **DIRECTIONS TO SUZANNE'S HOUSE**

Suzanne Chappell lives on the east side of Redlands, south of Interstate 10.

From either direction off the I-10:

1) Take the Yucaipa Blvd Exit

**Westbound** - turn Left (over the freeway)

**Eastbound** - turn right and then a quick

2) Left onto Outer Hwy 10 South – go 0.2 miles, turn

3) Right on Alta Vista (there is a Rocky's Mini Market on the corner) – 0.7 miles

4) LEFT on South Lane (There is a short, brick wall with the number 11311 on the southeast corner) – go 0.25 miles

**Arrive at:** 13020 South Lane

Redlands, CA 92373 (On the Right just past Ashforth)
