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## Challenge 2011 Weaving for Your Home Phase II: Dyeing

**Date: October 11, 2010**

**Where: The Corral, 241 N. Hwy 173, Lake Arrowhead, CA 92352.**

**When: 9:30 am**

**Bring: Your Coffee or beverage**

**Materials list:** Your **scoured (see below)** project warp, a bucket, rubber gloves, a large ziplock bag, your **LUNCH.**

The Mountain Weavers will host us to dye our measured warp at **The Corral**, 241 N. Hwy 173, Lake Arrowhead, CA 92352. **Driving instructions are on the website.** Arrive by 9:30 for an early start. We will be outside, so layered clothing is suggested.

Some of you may wish to meet at the museum around 8:30 for carpooling. It is a 45-minute drive, if you don't get stuck behind a big truck.

**Scouring your warp.** Fill a plastic bucket with enough hot water to cover your warp. Add either ½ teaspoon synthrapol or 1 tablespoon dishwashing soap for each gallon of hot water. Push your warp below the water and swish gently several times in 30 minutes. **Do NOT agitate! You don't want it to tangle.** Gently squeeze out water (no need to rinse) and bring in a zip Lock baggie. **Members will be supplying their own weft.** We will only dye the project warp.

**Announcement:** Marie Hartmann has written up directions for doing the **Discharge Shibori for Cotton T-shirts** like the one she wore to the September meeting.
