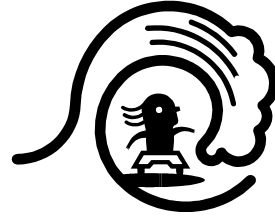

Take the 15 or 215 north to the Cajon Pass, continue on the 15 through the Pass to the High Desert and exit at Bear Valley Rd., turn right. (It is approximately 23-25 miles from the bottom of the pass to the Bear Valley exit.) Continue on Bear Valley for 6 miles and turn left on Apple Valley Rd., continue 2 miles to Yucca Loma Rd. (traffic light) and turn right . Go 1/2 mile to Choco and turn left, go past 2 houses and turn right on Titonka Rd. It's the 4th house on the right.
