VIKING KNITTING presented by Maggie Aguirre

I had the opportunity to take class from Marilyn Romatka at the 2012 Convergence and would like to share this jewelry making technique with you. You will be using thin craft wire and a simple looping around a dowel to create a complex-looking coil. This coil is then drawn through an increasingly smaller holes in a draw-plate to even out and lengthen the coil. Finishing closures will be demonstrated and included in handout.

Supplies needed

*26 gauge crafting wire (at least 8 yds) found at JoAnn's or Michaels

*3/8" - 1/2" dowel (at least 12" long)

*wire snips if you already have them
