**Beginning Weaving classes** on a harness (shaft) or rigid heddle loom are for beginning (no experience) and new weavers who still need some guidance.

Classes are held in Redlands and are limited to a maximum of four students. Table looms are available for rental.

A session consists of five 3-hour classes (week days), offered morning and evening, or four 3-hour classes on alternate Saturdays. **Cost: \$100.00 + Materials fee.**
