AGSEM will have *collections of mechanical ingenuity and crafts associated with the early days of the American farm and rural community on display, and the Vista Gem & Mineral Society Show* will also be taking place. There is something for all; bring the whole family. Free.

Sun. November 2, 10 am - 4 pm. **WeFF**, The Annual Weaving and Fiber Festival hosted by the Southern California Handweavers Guild (SCHG). There will be a members' weaving exhibit & sale, demonstrations, silent auction, Fashion show (announced by Trish Lange), door prizes, **vendors**, and many chances to meet and greet old and new friends with fiber interests like yours. Admission \$10 (cash only), free parking, lunch available. Directions can be found here.

I hope you will find some time make some new friends and get some new inspirations this month. And remember, there are a dozen guild mentors willing to mentor your **Something New**.

Fall 2014 Weaving Classes

Beginning Weaving

The Introduction to Weaving Classes on a harness (shaft) loom or rigid heddle loom are for beginning (no experience) and weavers who still need some guidance. A session consists of five 3-hour classes which are offered Wednesday evenings, Thursday mornings, or Saturday mornings. One or more projects will be completed during the course of instruction, but will require doing some weaving at home. Classes are conducted in Redlands, and require a membership in the IEHG guild. Students bring their own looms or may rent a table loom from the guild. Classes are limited to 3-4 students. Topics are

Basic weave structures with samples

Weaving and finishing your project

Measuring warp

Reading a project draft (as presented in magazines)

Warping your loom

Planning a project

Winding a shuttle

Costs: \$120 for five classes (Includes \$15 materials fee for one project)

Optional Loom rental \$10/month (\$150 security deposit)
