IEHG 2015 Spring Weaving Classes

Beginning Weaving

The Introduction to Weaving Classes on a harness (shaft) loom or rigid heddle loom are for beginning weavers (no experience) and weavers who still need some guidance. A session consists of six 3-hour classes, offered one morning or afternoon, one evening and Saturday morning.

Classes are limited to four students.

One or more projects can be completed in a session, but will require weaving at home.

Classes are conducted in Redlands and require a membership in the IEHG Guild.

Students bring their own loom or may rent one for \$10/month.

Topics covered include:

Basic weave structure with samples Yarns selection Planning a project

Measuring a warp Dressing the loom Winding a shuttle

Basic hem stitching Weaving your project Reading a Draft

Costs: \$120 for six classes. **\$15 Materials fee** for one project, if I supply the yarn

Optional Loom rental \$10/month, (**\$150 security deposit**)

Session dates:

Wed evenings: April 15, 22, 29, May 4, 20, 27 (skip May 13) Time: 6:30-9:30 p.m.

***Tuesday or Thursday:** Week of April 13 through week of May 25 (skip week of May 11).

Morning class would run at **9a.m.-noon**, an afternoon class would run **1-4p.m.**

Saturday mornings: April 18, 25, May 2, 9, 30, June 6 (skip May 16 and May 23. **Time: 9a.m.-noon**
